

Southwest Papua Province: 3,467 (minority)



VII. First Congress, ULMWP Provisional Government of West Papua, Jayapura, 20 November 2023

For official representatives of the seven Customary Regions





This congress took place at the urging of the West Papua people after the ULMWP Leaders Summit in Vanuatu. The people peacefully demonstrated for two days (6-7 Nov 2023) because they believed the leaders violated the Constitution by appointing leaders and constitutional bodies at an internal summit, rather than through Congress.

First Plenary Session, Legislative Council, West Papua Provisional Government, Jayapura, 28 June-4 July 2025 3,000 representatives from the seven Customary regions







The Plenary Session elected and inaugurated Benny Wenda (President); Edison Waromi (Prime Minister); Buchtar Tabuni (National Speaker); Diaz Gwejangge (Attorney General); 250 Senate Members, 350 Congress Members, 1,740 Regional Council Members, 7 Governors, and 12 Cabinet Ministers. It also adopted the ULMWP Provisional Government's Constitution and its Green Policy Framework.

ULMWP Provisional Government's instruments of governance for the Papuan state

- * A Speaker of Congress overseeing 350 members.
- * A Speaker of the Senate overseeing 250 members.
- * 1,740 council members from the 7 customary regions.
- * 7 governors of the 7 customary regions.
- * 12 Ministries under the Provisional Government of the ULMWP.
- * A State Sponsor from the African Caribbean Pacific Group.
- * International Lawyers for West Papua, chaired by Alex Sobel MP (British Labour Party politician).
- * Two negotiators, one from the political wing and the other a civil society representative.

VIII. Relations with other countries

The ULMWP Provisional Government has established relations with the African, Caribbean and Pacific Group (79 members), the European Union, and several states in Asia, Latin America and the Middle East.







IX. The priorities of the West Papua ULMWP Government to further negotiations between Papua and Indonesia under international supervision



- 1. Lobbying MSG member states to accept Papua as a full member of the Melanesian Spearhead Group.
- 2. Requesting UN member states to pressure Indonesia to open access for the UN Human Rights Delegation
- 3. Encouraging the formation of a UN Resolution.
